RENT/SELL YOUR PAINTING!

RENTAL PAINTING CONCEPT IS BENEFICIAL TO ARTISTS - EVEN BEGINNERS!

OUR AIM IS TO DISPLAY OUR PAINTINGS EVERYWHERE AND SPREAD HAPPINESS THROUGH ART!

- We are working to display our artworks in all homes, schools, hotels, hospitals and other places where people work.
- If you are interested in art but have no prior knowledge, you can learn art with us and earn money by working on art orders or through this concept of Rental Painting.
- To participate in this programme, an application form must be filled and a registration fee of Rs.100 has to be paid.
- You can contribute any number of paintings to this programme.
- You need not send your artwork to us immediately. You just need to send us the photographs of your artworks, their size and price.
- The photos of your artworks will be listed on our website and in our gallery as the artworks available to be rented. If your artwork is selected for hire, you will be informed. You should then send your artwork to us.
- The artworks are offered for rent for a period of 3 months.
- The monthly rent for an artwork varies from Rs.100 to Rs.5,000 depending on the size and labour of the work. This is determined by a separate team that takes care of the work.
- Once registered, you should stay in regular touch with the art gallery. If any of the artworks you have accepted to rent is sold, we must be informed immediately.
- Even if you have closed a sales deal for an artwork that you have given for rent, you will receive the artwork only after the end of the rental period.
- If we make a deal for the sale of your artworks that you have given us for rent, we will organise the sale and receive a commission of 30% from it.
- If your artwork is damaged during the rental period, we will offer you a solution to repair the damage. If it is lost, we will pay you the price of the artwork.
- Artworks given for rent must be framed and portable. Paintings on canvas, chart or paper will not be accepted.
